

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

THE UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA AND

JAYPEE EDUCATION SYSTEM

WHEREAS the original Memorandum, signed on June 19, 2006, expired on June 18, 2009. A renewal addendum to the original Memorandum was signed on April 6, 2009 and expired on April 6, 2012. The latest renewal addendum to the original Memorandum, signed April 9, 2012, expires April 9, 2015.

WHEREAS both the University of Florida and Jaypee Education System have expressed satisfaction with the program and a desire for it to continue.

THEREFORE this Addendum shall serve to renew the original Memorandum as described in the attached agreement. The Memorandum shall remain in effect five (5) years past the date of the last signature below. At the end of this period, both parties must re-evaluate the program and choose to extend or end the agreement by mutual consent.

THEREFORE It is expected that within the five-year duration of this agreement, the exchange will be fully balanced. If mutually agreed upon, each institution - regardless of how many students the partner school sends - may be allowed to send the maximum number of students per academic year. After five years, student activity in the agreement will be reviewed and will guide the decision to either renew or terminate the agreement.

COOPERATIVE AGREEMENT

By and Between the

JAYPEE EDUCATION SYSTEM [JIIT-JUIT-JIET]

and the

UNIVERSITY OF FLORIDA

This agreement is made and entered into by and between the University of Florida Board of Trustees, located in Gainesville, Florida, United States of America for the benefit of ACADEMICS AND RESEARCH, hereinafter referred to as "Florida," and the Jaypee Education System, India [comprising of the Jaypee Institute of Information Technology (JIIT), Noida; Jaypee University of Information Technology (JUIT), Solan; and the Jaypee Institute of Engineering & Technology (JIET), Guna, hereafter referred to as "Jaypee" The parties hereto agree as follows:

I. Philosophical Intent

- a. The primary objective of this agreement is the development of cooperative efforts between Florida and Jaypee, which will enhance the academic interchange between the two institutions. Recognizing the importance of mutual collaboration and the contributions to society made by institutions of higher education, the parties desire to promote exchange between the faculty and students of the two institutions as well as the exchange of academic and research information.
- b. Specific projects in an area of educational interest will be selected as a result of coordination by Florida and Jaypee at the appropriate administrative level in each institution. As these projects are developed, each will require a specific written agreement made in advance, setting forth the terms and conditions thereof and executed by authorized representatives of both institutions.

II. General Provisions

a. All research and other collaborative activities conducted pursuant to this agreement shall be conducted in accordance with the laws and regulations appropriate to each institution. In the case of Florida, these include the

laws of the United States of America and of the State of Florida, and the rules and regulations of the Board of Trustees and of the University of Florida. In the case of Jaypee, these are the laws of India and the rules and regulations of the Jaypee.

b. This agreement shall take effect when executed by the parties and shall terminate on June 18, 2009. The agreement may be renewed or amended by written mutual agreement. Either party may terminate this agreement by giving 60 days' written notice to the other party.

c. Notices with respect to this agreement shall be provided to the parties as indicated on Attachment A hereto, entitled "Administration of Program and Contact Information," which is incorporated by reference herein.
